

Networking Protocol Dependencies

For 1st Generation Networking Products

For NTP,
the network must either include an NTP server and allow unicast requests and responses on UDP Port 123, or the firewall must allow outbound requests and inbound responses to a remote server on UDP Port 123.

For DHCP,
the network must include a DHCP Server and allow broadcast requests on UDP Port 67 and broadcast responses on UDP Port 68.

For DNS,
the network must include a DNS Server and allow unicast queries and responses on UDP Port 53.

For HTTP,
the network must allow unicast requests and responses between endpoints on TCP Port 80. Configuration, operation or information pages may use unencrypted Basic Authentication for access control.
